#### Biography:

I have a national lead role with the NHS Wales Executive & Cardiff University to improve healthcare professional & public understanding on topics relevant to care in the last years of life & advance care planning education. This work, including my educational research work that has underpinned it, has been recognised internationally, including winning the European Association Palliative Care researcher of the year award at the 2019 World Congress in Berlin & the international excellence in patient care award from the Royal College of Physicians in London. I have given a Ted Talk on why subtleties in language & wording remain critical in modern healthcare. My medical education publications focus on improving public & healthcare professional understanding of complexity in serious illness. My writing has made it into international newspapers like the Washington Post, where my op-ed ended up being a top pick for 2019. I took part in a BBC Horizon programme alongside Kevin Fong, have talked about medical topics at the Edinburgh Fringe Festival, Hay Literary Festival, given a lecture at the Science Museum in London and have featured twice on the BBC's Listening Project. A few years ago I had a brief brush with fame, when my posthumous letter to David Bowie, which covers the components of good end of life care, went viral on the internet and in global newsrooms.
